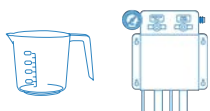

The Concentrate solution once diluted is excellent for large surface area disinfection such as floors, kennels and more.

Diluted Shelf Life: Once diluted with water, the solution is effective for up to 30 days, saving you time and money.

How to Use Prevail[™] Concentrate



STEP 1 Dilute the concentrate

Use a pump, measuring cup or mixing station. Dilute the concentrate at a 1:40 ratio (25 mL of Concentrate per 1 L of water) into a mop bucket, spray bottle or other application equipment.



STEP 2 Remember to apply a workplace label to the secondary container

Use a Prevail[™] Concentrate workplace label and record the lot number and expiry date to help you and your team keep track.



STEP 3 Pre-clean heavily soiled areas

Remove visible soil if required and pre-clean the surfaces by working from the least contaminated area to the most contaminated area.

STEP 4 Apply the diluted solution until surface is thoroughly wet

Apply the solution and ensure the entire surface area is evenly covered and appears visibly wet.



STEP 5 Allow surface to remain visibly wet for 5 minutes

Allowing surfaces to remain wet for 5 minutes kills viruses, bacteria and fungi per label instructions.

STEP 6 Allow to air dry

Allow the surface to air dry and rinse if needed.

Start Fresh

If you are switching from a previous cleaner and disinfectant to using Prevail[™] for the first time, start with fresh accessories and tools. Prevail[™] will remove build up from previous disinfectants and may cause a non-toxic reaction and musty odour. The odour will eventually disappear after a few times of using Prevail[™].

Measure. Measure. Measure.

Use a pump, measuring cup, mixing station or other dilution equipment. Measuring will ensure proper dilution and efficacy. Use AHP 1750 Test Strips to confirm that you have mixed or dispensed the correct dilution.

Follow the dilution ratios to ensure you are effectively achieving disinfection and conserving product. When diluted properly, Prevail[™] Concentrate is a cost-effective solution for your everyday cleaning and disinfectant needs.

Wait Before Wiping Dry

Always follow the required contact time. Consider setting a timer and walking away until the timer goes off.
